

Jaan Roos

Jaan Roos is a racewalker with a 10 year span, in M45 and M50, of Canadian record breaking performances, from 3000 metres, indoors and out, to 50 kilometres. Seventeen of the records are still standing. He was almost 50, when he competed at the senior level in the 1986 50km Pan Am Cup taking the Bronze as a team. His background in cross-country skiing competitions in Estonia likely contributed to his ability in racewalking. He formed the Ontario Racewalkers Club and was head coach, and is still very actively involved as a racewalking judge.
