## Jean Horne



Jean began competing in Masters track in 1984. As of 2012, she still holds records in 800m and 1500m outdoors and in 400, 800, 1500, mile and 3000 indoors, beginning in the W60 age category and up to W75.

She won gold in the 800 in her first WMA meet in 1989, and has since won over 20 medals in WMA events. She set a world record in the 800 in 1999 at Gateshead when she was 66.

After the toll of injuries from 25 plus years of middle distance running resulted in a change of events, she is beginning to add her name to W80 records in Racewalks. She is truly an athlete who continues to compete for the love of the sport!

She served on the Ontario Masters Board of Directors from 1997 through 2004.

Jean was inducted into the OMA Hall of Fame in 2006, and to the CMA HOF in 2009.
