June-Marie Provost began racewalking when she was 57, in 1990, and quickly showed her mastery of this highly technical event. After her record-setting beginning, she continued to improve her times. Her racewalking records, 29 altogether, span from 1500 metres to 20K, including indoor, outdoor, track and road races, with about half still standing. Her age-grading is consistently above 90%. She has competed at 9 World Masters Athletics championships, with many individual and team medals. Not only is she an outstanding competitor and hard-working athlete, she has given back to her sport as a coach and volunteer, frequently racing and then volunteering in the same meet.
