Molly Turner has excelled on all surfaces of athletics - indoor and outdoor track, road, and cross-country. She has excelled at distances from 800m to 30K, setting Canadian and world records and at Ontario, Canadian and world championships. She's earned a star on the Scarborough Walk of Fame, Athlete of the Year honours by Ontario Masters and CTV, and induction into the Canadian Masters Hall of Fame. Molly's record breaking achievements began with 800 metres, mile, 1500 and 3000 metres records in her 50's, and continued into her 60's adding 5k indoors and out, as well as road race records from 5K to 30K. The latter was the Around the Bay Road Race record for W60 set in 1998, when she was at age 64, which still stands. She has also served as an official, and is a familiar face at our cross-country meets at Sunnybrook Park.
