

Facilities

IAAF Standard mondo surface, 400m 9-lane track and jump facilities build for the 2015 PanAm Games.

A Class 1 track suitable for hosting Olympic and other top-tier competitions, it has a 400-metre track and an infield that supports throwing and jumping disciplines, as well as a scoreboard, professional broadcast capabilities, athlete change rooms, equipment storage and classroom space.

Spectators in the grandstand will have an unobstructed view of the field of play, as well as the natural landscape of the campus's protected Boyer Woodlot. The stadium provides permanent seating for 5000 spectators, with ample wheelchair accessibility. Elevator stops provide access to the media gondola and to wheelchair spaces above.

- Parking Capacity is over 2000 parking spaces in the University Campus within a 5 minute walk of the stadium
- A state-of-the-art scoreboard in the stadium, which is able to be interfaced with the timing and results processing system
- A quality sound system for the entire stadium, capable of announcements
- 9 Lanes on Straight
- 8 Lanes on Oval
- There are provisions for Fully Automatic Electronic timing
- Starting blocks are available
- 2 Simultaneous bi-directional long/triple jump venues
- 2 Simultaneous high jump venues
- One Simultaneous Bi-directional PV Venues
- Hammer and Weight Permitted on infield
- Shot put permitted on track infield
- All WMA Hurdles Settings will be marked
- All WMA Hurdle Heights will be available (68.6 cm)
- Adjustable Steeplechase Barriers and Water Barriers
- Pole Vault Poles may be available
